READ THE STORY. EXPERIENCE THE BIBLE.

AS YOU READ CHAPTER 4

As a church we will all be reading chapter four of The Story this week! Join in as a family and read The Story together or each read your own versions. We encourage you to talk about what you are reading and pray together! The questions and prayers below can serve as a guide for your family discussion!

1. God provided for Moses through his entire life. How did God care for Moses at the following times: When he was a baby? When he was asking Pharaoh to let the Israelites go? When they left Egypt?

Prayer: God, thank you for the story of Moses and all that we can learn from it. We praise you for how you cared for Moses and the Israelites. You are big and powerful and we love you! Amen!

2. God cared for and provided for Moses in a lot of ways! How does God provide for you? Share day to day things or a story of a specific time you remember.

Prayer: God, we know that you are with us and that you care for us! Thank you for how you have provided for our family. Help us to see how you are caring for us through good times and bad. Amen.

3. God uses lots of ways to care for people. What are ways that we can help care for others?

Prayer: God, thank you for all the ways you have blessed us! We pray that everyone is treated equally and that you would continue to bless our family. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

4. It is good to be thankful for what we have and how God is caring for us. How can we give thanks to other people? How do we give thanks to God? (For others: using manners, being respectful, doing nice things. For God: giving thanks in prayer, through worship, through our actions, etc.)

Prayer: God, we give you thanks! Thank you for who you are, for how you love us, for how you care for us and provide for us! We want to give you praise! Amen.

5. Pharaoh had hardened his heart against God. What can we do to help people see the truth about God? (Brainstorm together. Answers could include: pray for them, be their friend, tell them about Jesus, invite them to church, etc.)

Prayer: Lord, thank you for loving everyone more than we can image! We love you and pray that you would help us to show others what your love means to us. Help us to be a light to others and spread the joy of your love! Amen.
