### Notice About the re-opening of St. Alphonsa Church Cambridge

Greetings from St. Alphonsa Syro Malabar Parish Cambridge!

Dear Parishioners,

It is our awaiting dream to open our church for physical Holy Qurbana. The time is up. The Government of Ontario and the Ministry of Health have given permission to re-open the places of worship. **So, we are planning to resume the physical Holy Qurbana at St. Alphonsa Parish Cambridge on Sept 20, 2020. Holy Qurbana will be at 04.00 pm.**

The health and safety of the faithful, clergy, staff and volunteers are of utmost importance and some precautions and training must be put in place first. As per Province's rules regarding the social distancing and as per the directions from St. Ambrose Church we are instructed to limit the number of individuals attending Holy Qurbana. Therefore, respectively ask you and your family please do register for the Sunday Holy Qurbana. Sunday Holy Mass registration link shall be done through google drive and will be sent to you via parish email. You will have to confirm your availability by Wednesdays. Registration link shall be sent to you one week before for each Sundays. Live streaming will available of the same Holy Mass.

#### Please read the steps before registering for mass:

1. Physical distancing is to be observed everywhere on the Church property except for members of the same household.
2. The entrance is through the main door. The exit is only through the side door of the church (Choir Side)
3. We won't be able to accommodate walk-ins and not confirmed worshippers for Holy Mass due to number restrictions.
4. Please plan to arrive early to allow for timely admittance for Mass.
5. When the Holy Mass begins, the doors will be closed.
6. While you are waiting in line, please stay 6ft apart.
7. Please use Hand Sanitizer available at the entrance
8. Pews are marked where you and/or your family may sit. Please comply with seating arrangements and instructions of the volunteers.
9. Kindly always bring your own masks and wear it.

10. Please keep physical distancing during the time of Holy Communion. Mask is compulsory while you line for the Holy Communion.
11. Please keep Physical distance while you exit.
12. Avoid touching the statues. No socialization after Mass either inside or outside the building.
13. Sunday collection baskets are arranged at the entrance and please offer your donations as you enter the Church. It is advisable to E-transfer your donation through [stalphonsa2026@gmail.com](mailto:stalphonsa2026@gmail.com) with your envelope number.
14. Kids below 10yrs and Adults above 65yrs are requested to stay at home.
15. WASHROOMS – please ensure children are accompanied by a parent and to be used only if really necessary.
16. Further instructions will be provided during the Mass.
17. Please remember that you are coming to Church at your own risk. You are responsible and liable to take all precautions for your own safety and for the safety of others.

**The following MUST stay home for the sake of the parish community:**

- Individuals with COVID-19 or live with someone with COVID-19.
- Individuals who have been exposed to COVID-19 in the past 2 weeks or to someone with COVID-19.
- Individuals who are ill, even with the slightest symptoms, especially fever, dry cough, shortness of breath and flu-like symptoms.
- Those who have recently travelled outside of Canada.
