RESOLUTION NO. 2003-20

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A STANDBY CHARGE

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Indian Valley Community Services District ("the District") on July 9, 2003, duly adopted its Resolution No. 2003-9 (the "Resolution Initiating Proceedings"), which proposed to levy a standby charge on those properties currently receiving water service and on those properties where water service is immediately available (the "Property").

WHEREAS, the Board on August 8, 2003, held a duly noticed public hearing (the "hearing") at which time the Board heard all objections and protests to the proposed standby charge.

WHEREAS, written protests against the proposed standby charge were not presented by a majority of the property owners;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Indian Valley Community Services District:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. Levy of Standby Charge. The Board hereby levies a standby charge on the Property. The annual standby charge shall equal \$15,467 divided by the total parcels.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
