RESOLUTION OF THE INDIAN VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE SANITARY SEWER MANAGEMENT
PLAN FOR THE GREENVILLE SEWER SYSTEM(SSMP)

WHEREAS, the Indian Valley Community Services District (IVCSD) is a community services district duly formed under and operating pursuant to all of the laws and provisions of the community services district Law, Government Code 61000 et. Seq., and

WHEREAS, The District operates a sewer system in Greenville, CA; and

WHEREAS, On May 2, 2006, the State Water Resources Control Board Order No.2006-0003-Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems was adopted and implemented. The IVCSD's sanitary sewer collection system is subject to this WDR. The purpose of the WDR is to develop a regulatory mechanism to provide a consistent statewide approach for reducing sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs).

The WDR also requires that IVCSD's Board of Directors approve the SSMP upon completion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Board of Directors of IVCSD has reviewed the SSMP presented, and hereby approves the adoption of said SSMP as its official sanitary sewer management plan.
