A RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION BY THE INDIAN VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT REQUESTING THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION TO TAKE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ANNEXATION FO THE DIAMOND MOUNTAIN TERRITORY

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of the Indian Valley Community Services District wishes to initiate proceedings pursuant to the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985, commencing with Section 65000 on the Government Code, for the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the territory proposed for annexation is inhabited and a description of the boundaries of the territory is set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, this proposal is not consistent with the sphere of influence of the affected district; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to provide that the proposed annexation be subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Owners to provide a survey of Diamond Mountain territory at their own expense.
2. Owners to pay all costs of annexation into Indian Valley Fire District.

WHEREAS, the reason for the proposed annexation is as follows:

1. To provide fire protection for Diamond Mountain territory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Indian Valley Community Services District, that this Resolution of Application is adopted and approved and the Plumas Local Agency Formation Commission is requested to take proceedings for the annexation as described in Exhibit A, according to the terms and conditions stated above and in the manner provided by the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985.
