RESOLUTION NO. 99-4

RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION  
MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE PROPOSED  
INCLUSION OF PROPERTIES TO THE SPHERE OF INFLUENCE  
OF THE INDIAN VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

**WHEREAS**, a Resolution of Application for an annexation of territory to the Indian Valley Community Services District outside its current Sphere of Influence was filed with the Executive Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Officer of the Commission called the proposed amendment to the Sphere of Influence of said District for public hearing on April 15, 1999, gave the required notice of hearing, reviewed the proposal, prepared a report including his recommendations thereon, and has furnished a copy thereof to each person entitled to receive a copy; and

**WHEREAS**, said hearing was held on April 15, 1999, and this Commission heard from the interested parties, considered the factors determined by the Commission to be relevant to this proposal, including, but not limited to, those factors specified in Section 56425 of the Government Code; and


**WHEREAS**, the boundaries of said territory proposed for inclusion in the Sphere of Influence of the Indian Valley Community Services District as shown in Exhibit A (legal description) and Exhibit B (map) are found to be definite and certain.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Commission does hereby resolve, determine, and order as follows:

1. That the proposed revision to the Sphere of Influence of the Indian Valley Community Services District complies with the provisions of Government Code Section 56425.
2. That the Commission has reviewed the proposed revision to the Sphere of Influence of said District according to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and finds that it is categorically exempt under Class 19 of the CEQA Guidelines.
3. That the Sphere of Influence of the Indian Valley Community Services District is hereby amended to include territory described in Exhibits A and B, said action adopted and approved by this Commission.

The Board of Directors of the District has **one year** to complete proceedings for the annexation. This is one year from the date of approval by the Local Agency Formation Commission (April 15, 1999).

At least **fifteen days** before the public hearing, a **notice of public hearing** must be published, posted, and mailed.

1. **Published notice** must run in the Indian Valley Record at least fifteen days before the date of the hearing. Usually, you have to get the notice to the paper the Thursday of the week before the date you want it to run. You only have to publish it once. I've enclosed a sample notice for you.
2. **Posted notice** must be posted on or near the door of the meeting room, starting at least fifteen days before the date of the meeting and continuing until the meeting takes place.
3. **Mailed notice** must be sent to:

The notice of public hearing will work for all these notices.

Once the public hearing has been held, the Board must make certain findings and pass a resolution. I've enclosed a sample resolution for you.
