RESOLUTION NO. 99-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF PLUMAS
MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION TO
THE INDIAN VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
(NORTH VALLEY/DIAMOND MOUNTAIN ANNEXATION, LAFCO FILE NO. 1-ANNX-99)

WHEREAS, the resolution of application for annexation to the Indian Valley Community Services District was filed with the Executive Officer of the Plumas County Local Agency Formation Commission in accordance with the Cortese/Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985 (Title 5, Division 3 of the Government Code Section 56000, *et seq*) for the purpose of providing fire protection; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has reviewed the proposal and prepared a report, including recommendations thereon, the proposal and report having been presented to and considered by this Commission; and

WHEREAS, this Commission received all oral and written protests, objections, and evidence with respect to this proposal and the report of the Executive Officer; and

WHEREAS, the proposal is found to be consistent with the affected Sphere of Influence, as the Sphere has been amended to include the North Valley/Diamond Mountain area.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission does hereby resolve, determine, and order the annexation approved subject to the following terms and conditions, as presented in the Indian Valley Community Services District Resolution of Application approved October 15, 1998:

1. The regular county assessment roll will be utilized.
2. The affected territory shall not be subject to taxes resulting from outstanding or authorized general bonds of the Indian Valley Community Services District.
3. The proposed annexation is exempt under Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines.
4. The territory requested to be annexed is inhabited, pursuant to the Cortese/Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985, Section 56046, and is assigned the following short form designation: **North Valley/Diamond Mountain Annexation to the Indian Valley Community Services District.**
5. Owners of the property within the territory proposed to be annexed will provide a survey at their expense.
6. Owners of the property within the territory proposed to be annexed will pay all costs of annexation.

The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted by the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Plumas at the meeting held on the 15th of April, 1999, by the following vote:
