

Indian Valley Community Services District Receives \$280,000 Grant

GREENVILLE, CA – The Indian Valley Community Services District (IVCSD) has received a planning grant from the California State Water Resources Control Board (SWRB) to begin the process of replacing its aged water transmission lines.

The planning funded by this grant will enable the district to apply for a second phase grant to accomplish the actual construction/replacement of those portions of the water system that are leaking.

The planning grant funding will pay for;

- A leak detection survey to establish high priority areas for pipeline replacement
- GIS data compilation recording pipelines, wells, water sources, treatment facilities, tanks and reservoirs
- Engineering reports (conceptual design & probable cost)
- Environmental documentation and analysis
- Engineering plans and specifications based on refined information from tasks noted above

“We’ve worked hard with the folks at SWRB to be successful in this grant process. The District could not have done such a project without this funding. We look forward to getting started!”, said Chris Gallagher, IVCSD General Manager.

The CSD will be outreaching for a contractor to begin work by early to mid-summer.
