CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER NOTICE

On July 26, 2021, a boil water notice was issued to all Indian Valley CSD- Crescent Mills customers. High water demand due to the Dixie Fire operations led to very low water levels in our storage tank. To keep up with demand and ensure as much water as possible was supplied for fire operations, we supplemented our normal supplies with untreated water hauled in from nearby streams. After the hauled water was no longer delivered, we had to ensure that all untreated water was sufficiently flushed from our system. Following a sufficient water turnover via flushing we then disinfected the water distribution system for a long enough contact time to ensure any pathogens attached to pipes were inactivated. After sufficient chlorine residuals were detected on all ends of the distribution system, we collected bacteriological samples from throughout the distribution system on September 8, 2021; none of those samples showed the presence of total coliform bacteria or *E. Coli* bacteria in the water. Based on these test results, it appears all contamination has been eliminated, and **the water is now safe to drink.**
