

RESOLUTION NO 99-06

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
INDIAN VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICE DISTRICT
ORDERING THE "NORTH VALLEY/DIAMOND MOUNTAIN ANNEXATION TO THE INDIAN
VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICE DISTRICT"

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Plumas adopted its Resolution Nos. 99-4 and 99-5 on April 15, 1999, making determinations and approving the proposed annexation to the Indian Valley Community Services District to territory described in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of annexation as approved by the Local Agency Formation Commission are as follows:

1. The regular county assessment roll will be utilized.
2. The affected territory shall not be subject to taxes resulting from outstanding or authorized general bonds of the District.
3. The proposed annexation is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act under Section 1506 (b) (3) of the CEQA Guidelines.
4. The territory requested to be annexed is inhabited, pursuant to the Cortese/Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985, Section 56046, and is assigned the following short form designation: **North Valley/Diamond Mountain Annexation to the Indian Valley Community Services District.**
5. Owners of the property within the territory proposed to be annexed will provide a survey at their expense.
6. Owners of the property within the territory proposed to be annexed will pay all costs of annexation.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners certifies that the proposed annexation is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act under Section 15061 (b) (3) of the CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this annexation was called for and held by the Board at the place and time noticed therefore on August 18th, 1999 ; and

WHEREAS, the value of the written protests filed and not withdrawn is less than 25 percent in the territory proposed to be annexed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Indian Valley Community Services District finds and orders:


- a. The value of written protests filed and not withdrawn is less than 25 percent in the territory proposed to be annexed.
- b. The territory described in Exhibits "A" and "B" is annexed, and the Secretary of the Indian Valley Community Services District is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission of Plumas County.
