2018 Arizona Election Update

Around 60,000 ballots are left to be counted and the only race essentially left to be decided is the LD 28 Senate race which continues to tighten. As information comes in, we'll continue to keep you updated.

AZ Secretary of State Update

While the race is still not official, Governor Ducey this afternoon congratulated State Senator Katie Hobbs (D) on her victory over GOP nominee, Steve Gaynor for Secretary of State. However, Hobbs has still not declared victory and the GOP nominee, Steve Gaynor has yet to concede the race. Hobbs currently leads Gaynor by 13,199 votes.

AZ Senate LD 28 Update

Going into the weekend, Republican State Senator Kate Brophy McGee still leads Paradise Valley teacher, Christine Marsh (D), but only by 284 votes. Arizona's recall threshold is a 50-vote or less margin for state legislative candidates. There is a substantial difference between operating a legislative chamber with a 16 vote majority versus 17 votes. This race is still too close to call.
