You'll only get notifications about your child's items. You can access your child's journal via iOS app or on the web. One easy fund raising activity we support is the Bags 2 School collection which has been booked for Tuesday 20th November. Further details and a donation bag will be sent home shortly but in the meantime, please save up unused clothing and other suitable items for this easy fund raising activity

The annual Breamore House Fun Run is being held on **Sunday 28th October at 9.30am**. This year, children have the opportunity to participate by running 1, 2 or 3km around the beautiful Breamore Estate with all proceeds from the children's run being donated to Breamore Primary School! Each lap of the course is 1km in length. Children under 9 can choose to run 1 lap for £5 or 2 laps for £8 while the distance for children aged 9 or 10 is 3km for £8. Runs are not timed however all finishers receive a medal. Entry is through the School and details will be advised shortly.

Children 11 years and older can also run but they will need to enter directly through the Breamore House Fun Run website at www.riderhq.com/events/78043/breamore-5k--10k-0/enter. The timed distance of

5km costs £14 which includes refreshments and a medal for all finishers.
