Misconduct Fines Policy

Any player receiving a yellow or red card during a game will subsequently receive a fine/administration fee (yellow cards) or a fine/administration fee and a suspension (red cards) from Hampshire FA.

The club will ensure all misconduct fines and associated paperwork are returned to Hampshire FA but it is the responsibility of the player/players parents to reimburse the club for any fines or administration charges that have been payed.

It is the managers/coaches duty to complete the paperwork and return it, along with any fine or administration fee that is payable, before the due date indicated. Fines and administration fees may be payed from any subs collected as long as it is indicated on the Finance Form when subs are subsequently submitted to the Treasurer.

A copy of the paperwork must be made prior to returning it to Hampshire FA and presented to the player/players parents at the next available opportunity (game or training) in order to obtain reimbursement for any fines or administration fees and to inform the player/players parents of any suspension to be served. If the next available opportunity is not for several weeks due to lack of fixtures or close season, it is advised to deliver the paperwork to the players/players parents home.

It is important to return the paperwork to Hampshire FA within the stipulated time scale indicated on it. Failure to do so will incur further financial penalties and possible extensions to suspension periods.
