Kit Policy

Crofton Saints Youth Football Club will ensure all teams have a full football kit to play games as defined in the list below.

Teams are encouraged to seek sponsor funding to help with the financing of kit. However, not having a sponsor does not necessarily deny the team from obtaining a new playing kit. Under these circumstances the kit will be financed by central club funds and will be discretionally replaced on a two year cycle.

What the club will finance:

- Shirts (with numbers - names not permitted)
- Shorts
- Socks
- First Aid Kit
- Minimum training requirements including footballs, bibs, cones and mini-soccer goals
- FA RESPECT Barriers
- The 4 off bespoke trophies i.e. Players Player, Supporters Player, Most Improved & Managers Player awards for end of season presentations
- Rain Jackets

What the club will not finance:

This list is not exhaustive,
if in doubt - ask!

- Shin Pads
- Goalkeepers' gloves
- Away kit
- Training kit
- Tour T-shirts and Hoodies
- Individual medals for any end of season presentation
- End of season functions e.g. paintballing, 10 pin bowling; any such events must be self funded

Away kit

The club does have several away kits available for use by teams should the need arise. However, if a team would like their own personal away kit it must be funded through sponsorship.

Purchasing kit and other items

All purchases must be organised through Mark Sanford (masnaks@sky.com / 07547 043239 / 01329 664671).
Once the order has been agreed the Kit Order will be sent to Klub Kits to process the order.

Our current preferred kit supplier is Klub Kits, 18 Palmerston Business Park, Palmerston Drive, Fareham, PO14 1DJ and it is recommended that all purchases are made through them.

Small purchases of football related items only in accordance with the above list may be made from Klub Kits of up to £50 with funds obtained from subs. Klub Kits are to be notified which team is making the purchase, with the purchase subsequently indicated on the Finance Form when subs are submitted to the club Treasurer.

Any sponsorship money that has been secured can be presented to the Treasurer who will provide a letter of receipt for the sponsors records. However, if the sponsor would like to pay Klub Kits directly so they can obtain a receipt directly this can be done but only if the amount of sponsorship covers the full cost of the kit.
