An Ordinary Day
Psalm 23:2-3a

- *He makes me lie down in green pastures. (REST)*
- *He leads me beside still waters. (REFRESHING)*
- *He restores my soul. (RENEWAL)*



An Ordinary Day

Psalm 23:3b-4

- *He leads me in paths of righteousness (right paths) for his name's sake.*
- *Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death (valley of deep darkness),*
- *I will fear no evil, for you are with me;*
- *your rod and your staff, they comfort me.*



An Ordinary Day
Psalm 23:5-6a

- *You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;*
- *you anoint my head with oil;*
- *my cup overflows.*
- *Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life,*

- *Celebration – Comfort - Commission* (vv. 5-6a)
- *Profession of Faith and Work of Faith* (v. 6b)
