## BOT Elections

Our school is undertaking a parent election for our School Board. This process has started with the issuing of nomination papers to our caregiver community. We are looking for 5 parent representatives for the Board of Trustees. If you submit a nomination form through the portal please also let the office know so we can check your details are there.

**This year the voting will be available online or by mail.**

Nomination forms have already been sent out. They went out via email if we have your email registered with us (Check your Spam box) If we have no email registered with us it went out via mail. All parents have voting rights so everyone should have been sent the form. **If you haven't been sent a form please call the office and we can get one to you.** If you drop a nomination form to the office we will send it onto our returning officers.

**Nominations close Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 12.00 p.m.** Voting papers/online voting instructions will follow. **Election day is Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September.**

We had our Board meeting on Tuesday night. Thanks to those who were able to attend and see what we are about. We looked at the swimming progress report and were updated on our students writing progress. The results weren't as good as we had hoped and we encourage you to promote writing as an activity your children might like to do in their spare time. i.e. write to grandparents, relatives, write a story to share with the family, write out a recipe. We feel with the lockdowns and covid closures our regular writing times have diminished and with face to face calling on devices students are writing less. Like every activity we do the more we do it the better we get at it.

## Property issues

You can see that our new classrooms are finally being constructed. The ground works are underway. This means that the gate by the hall will be out of use until construction is completed. The rain has also made our field unusable for a while.

## Parking and traffic.

Please be aware that with the colder weather we have more cars trying to access our streets for pick ups. Many people are parking dangerously and illegally while waiting for their children after school. If possible park further from the school and walk to pick your child up. The corner of Raglan and Pembroke street is of particular concern as parking near the corner restricts views of traffic and could result in a pedestrian being hit or another vehicle having a crash. The other problematic area is outside the Harlech Street gate. There is always a lot of congestion there. Council traffic wardens are going to be patrolling the area after school due to safety complaints and issuing tickets to people illegally parked. Please help us keep our tamariki/children safe.

Assemblies are still on and back to our regular slot on a Friday morning. We ask that you wear a mask please. See you there.

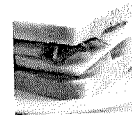

If you have pre-schoolers who will be turning five in the next year please could you let the school office know so that we can add them to our new entrant list.

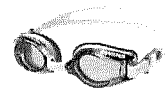
### School Board Parent Election 2022
