

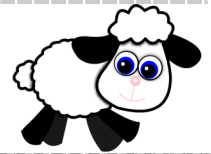

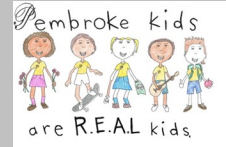

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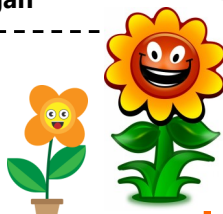
### Otago Regional Council would like to hear what you want for the future of your waterways?
