

## Respite Program

The Eight Northern Indian Pueblos Council, Inc. has expanded services to assure the health and well being of our elders by providing the respite program. The intent of the program is to provide assistance with the respite care for the primary caregiver of the home-bound frail eligible elder (age 55 or older) or who has been discharged from the hospital. Each primary caregiver will be able to utilize time off away from the elders to prevent burn-out.

### Qualifications for provider:

- **Must be 18 or older**
- **Drug test**
- **Background check**
- **CPR & First Aid certification**

**Please look in on the elders in your area, they may need help, or just a good visit from you.**

## Program Eligibility:

Age qualifications for natives 55+ non-natives 65+. Individuals who do not meet the age eligibility must pay \$3.50 per meal.

Eligible seniors for congregate( walk-Ins) and homebound services must have the following paper work filled out with the senior site manger at the time of signing up for services.

- **SAMS registration form**
- **Nutrition assessment**
- **ADL/IQADL assessment**

## Homebound Meals

Seniors must be within the age required and have a **doctor's note** to receive meals delivered.
