Amount:

\$500 Scholarship (\$250 awarded each semester of the freshman year). Deadline March 31st.

Eligibility:

Senior female student graduating from Edmond Public Schools and going into the field of education. Preference will be given to applicants with an interest in teaching science, math or STEM.

Criteria:

3.0 High School GPA to apply

Must maintain a 2.5 college GPA for second semester funding

Submissions Required:

500 word essay "As you are choosing a career in education, how will you contribute to the profession?"

One letter of recommendation from a high school teacher
