Thank you for registering for the annual Putt FORE Public Education!

We look forward to seeing you on **October 5th** at the annual Putt FORE Public Education golf tournament! We are so glad you can join us for this charity golf event at KickingBird Golf Club in Edmond. On behalf of all of us at the Edmond Public Schools Foundation, we are excited to welcome you to this special day of giving back to our schools.

There are always needs in our public schools, but this year more than ever, the needs are amplified. Most years, the support the community provided through the EPS Foundation funds a wide variety of needs including: awarding classroom grants, funding for mental health and social emotional curriculum, supporting special needs, funding the arts, awarding scholarships and providing leadership opportunities through its Student Ambassador program. This year, all of these programs still exist, with additional needs due to the pandemic.

We know this year is unique and want to assure you that the health and safety of all event participants and our staff remains our top priority. As such, we are following guidance provided in [KickingBird Golf Club's COVID19 policies](#) that align with CDC guidelines.

- Please have each golfer on your team register for the event by providing their email and cell phone number to anita.nash@edmondschools.net. This will allow us to have each golfer's contact information in case of any need to follow up after the tournament. This will also give them access to the online event page. A text will be sent to each golfer following their check-in with additional information regarding KickingBird Covid19 policies and their assigned hole to start the tournament. This is also how payments can be made for games and auction items to ensure social distancing. **All golfers are required to provide their email and cell number prior to event day.**
- Please make all purchases of games (Swing String and Student Drivers) prior to the tournament by 10/2/2020. This is done through the ClickBid event page <https://epsf.cbo.io> and you must log in using the **cell phone number you provided** (please do not set up a new registration). We will place a card in your team envelope detailing which items have been purchased for you team. 1 Swing String per team and maximum 3 Student Driver purchases per team.
- We are asking all event participants, volunteers, and staff to wear face masks in the common areas of the event. Please feel free to remove your mask when golfing or while staying six feet apart, but have your mask on anytime you approach someone or go inside the clubhouse or restroom. Also, please practice physical distancing and maintain at least a safe six-foot distance. We want everyone attending to feel safe! Read more about the [KickingBird Covid 19 policies](#).
- Each golfer will have their swag bag already placed on their cart stocked with water, snacks and more! There will be two water tents on the course with bottled water in place of the water coolers usually found on the course. Please go straight to your cart when you arrive with your golf bag. Boxed lunches will be available at a table close to the cart area that you can also take on your cart with you. There will be no registration area and we will know you have arrived when we see your bag on your cart. There will be volunteers available if you have questions. There will be no in-person activities or awards following the round of golf, so please feel free to take your clubs back to your car when the round is over. Awards will be announced on the [ClickBid](#) event site.
