All volunteers must be 18 years of age or older and an orientation, which ensures that your experience at the festival is enjoyable and successful!

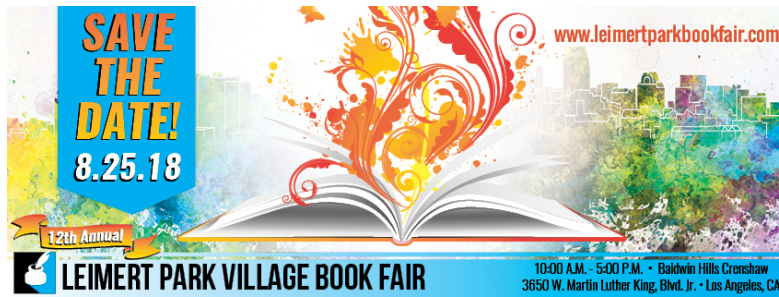

Founded in 2007 by Cynthia E. Exum, the Leimert Park Village Book Fair is produced in partnership with Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs, City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles. Since its inception this annual book fair has become a much-anticipated cultural tradition in the community providing authors and other participants an opportunity to promote their newest works as well as meet some of their fans up close and personal. Last year, the book fair was a great success with more than 75 authors, writers, storytellers, poets and spoken-word performers participating.

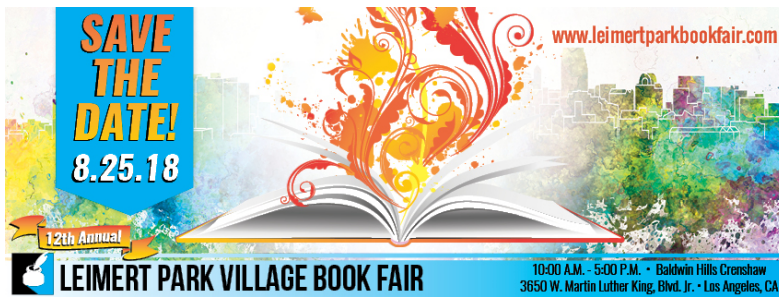

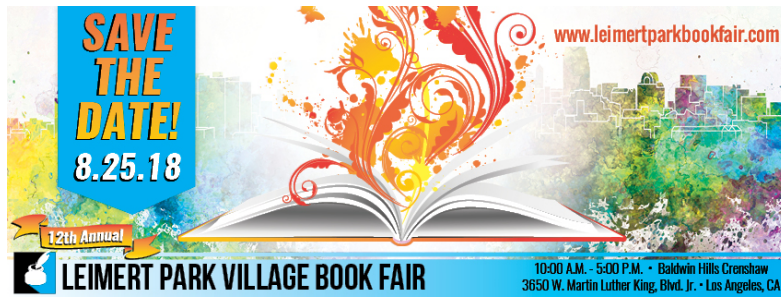

Description of Volunteer Assignment

Author Escorts/Author Hospitality – Volunteers will greet and check-in authors as they arrive at hospitality areas; assist with set up and breakdown, including food and beverages; escort authors to their stages; and assist stages with logistics and production during author appearances. Volunteer Orientation is mandatory for this assignment.

Book Shop – Assist in operating the festival's mini book stores, which includes inventorying books, conducting sales, working the credit card machines, and answering questions about the books/authors. Volunteer Orientation is mandatory for this assignment.

Crafts Corridor – Assist exhibitors with arts and crafts projects geared toward children; help keep the craft areas tidy; engage the participating children and families. Must love working with kids!

Demographic Surveys – Outgoing volunteers are needed to encourage festival-goers to complete surveys. This involves strolling the grounds of the festival in teams.

Demonstration Kitchen – Volunteers will assist chefs backstage, serve samples to the crowd and to help with clean up, and assist with other duties requested.

Exhibitor Hospitality – Volunteers will greet and check-in exhibitors and sponsors as they arrive at hospitality areas, and assist with set up and breakdown, including food and beverages. Volunteers will also serve as liaisons for the festival's 100+ exhibitors, and will stroll the festival grounds to assist exhibitors as needed. Hospitality experience is recommended.

Hands-On Projects – Volunteers will assist facilitators with hands-on projects for adults and workshops based on the literary arts.

Information Booth/Merchandise Sales – Volunteers will greet and give festival information to the public. FAQ's sheets, maps, and schedules will be provided. Volunteers may also collect donations and conduct sales of festival merchandise. Volunteer Orientation is mandatory for this assignment.

Parking Control – Volunteers will be posted at entrances of parking areas to check parking passes and direct drivers to the correct areas.

Recycling Crew – Green-minded volunteers are needed to assist with the festival's recycling program. Responsibilities may include encouraging festival-goers to recycle and collecting and sorting recycling.

Storybook Costumes – Volunteers are needed to wear storybook character costumes for the Storybook Parade and roving throughout the festival. This position offers a small stipend of \$50 per shift.

Storybook Costume Escorts – Volunteers will assist the Storybook Costume volunteers to get into the costumes and navigate the festival, ensuring the comfort and safety of the volunteers.
