Not for profit organizations with Paid Staff will be assessed annual dues based on the schedule posted to the left.

Associate Rate - \$110.00

This category applies to

- ♦ Individual Realtors associated with a MEMBER Broker/Owner agency
- ♦ Employees who serve as area representatives for larger or corporate businesses that do not have an office in Coles County
- ♦ Community residents who have a desire to support the Chamber and community with no association to a business

Retired Individuals - \$70.00

Individuals who are 65 years or older. Member will be listed by name only, with no association to a business.

Church Rate - \$230.00

Flat rate applies to all churches, regardless of size or number of paid employees.

Invoices for Chamber membership investments are sent out annually, usually around September 1.

The Chamber of Commerce serves as an advocate organization for area business. Investments paid to the Chamber are not a charitable tax deduction for federal income tax purposes. However, they may be tax deductible as ordinary and necessary business expenses, subject to restrictions imposed as a result of Chamber lobbying activities. The non-deductible portion of your dues is estimated at 5%.
