TCESD No.12 is a fully paid career fire department that covers 95 square miles of northeast Travis County. The district provides fire & medical first-response to Northeast Travis County incorporating the cities of Manor, and Webberville. TCESD No.12 is a growing, progressive department with three full-time staffed stations running around 4,000 alarms annually. The district plans on adding a fourth unit into service in 2021. TCESD No.12 has purchased two new Pierce Enforcer PUC's to be delivered 2021. The district is currently seeking property for station 4 and beginning design/specifications of a Quint/Ladder Truck.
