

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$ 0.10 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Travis County Emergency Services District No. 12 (ESD12).

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$ 0.10 per \$100

NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$ 0.0978 per \$100

VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$ 0.1037 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the Fiscal Year 2021 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Travis County ESD 12 from the same properties in both the FY 2020 tax year and the FY2021 tax year. The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate. The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Travis County ESD 12 is proposing to increase property taxes for the FY2021 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON 8/31/2020; 6:30 p.m. at 11200 Gregg Ln., Manor, TX 78653. The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Travis County ESD 12 is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Board of Commissioners by contacting the Travis County ESD 12 District Office or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

Your taxes owed under any of the Tax Rates mentioned above can be calculated as follows: Property tax amount = (tax rate) x (taxable value of your property) / 100.
