

Guide to Iseli Codes

AB GRADE – these plants are not quite up to Iseli’s high standards but usually they are still great looking specimens and cost a bit less.

BB – balled-and-burlapped, these plants are grown in the ground and then dug up shortly before shipping and placed in a burlap sack. Container-grown plants typically perform better in our climate but we still offer this choice to you.

HINDUPAN – a style of pruning similar to pompon that gives a plant that Japanese garden look.

LPP – this pot size is approximately a 4” round pot.

POMPON – a style of pruning similar to hindupan.

POT20P & POT15P – these plants were grown in the ground but have now been dug up and placed into 15 or 20 gallon containers. This method of growing is slightly more desirable than B&B because the plants have had time to adjust to not being in the ground and it makes their transition easier.

RGP – these plants are in round pots that are approximately 6” across. A great choice for collecting lots of small, inexpensive plants.

STD – these plants have been grafted on top of a single trunk. The number included indicates the height of the trunk and does not include the height of the plant above the graft.

TOP LOAD – usually reserved for large specimens, this code means that the plant has to be loaded into the truck carefully and often requires a slightly higher charge for shipping.
