Key vocabulary

Village - a group of houses and associated buildings, larger than a hamlet and smaller than a town, situated in a rural area.

Town - a built-up area with a name, defined boundaries, and local government, that is larger than a village and generally smaller than a city.

City - usually larger than a town and of more importance than a town.

County - an area of local government.

Continent - a continent is a large solid area of land. Earth has seven continents. In order from largest to smallest, they are Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe, and Australasia.

Physical features - the natural world (weather / climate / mountains / volcanoes / rivers / lakes / oceans).

Human features - the way humans change their surroundings (settlements / trade / economic activity).
