



Supervisory Special Agent **Drew Northern** is the Chief Division Counsel, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Indianapolis, Indiana. Drew earned a B.A. in Political Science and Spanish from Wabash College, a J. D. from Indiana University School of Law-Indianapolis where he was the Executive Production Editor of the International and Comparative Law Review and an M.B.A. from Webster University. He is a licensed attorney in the State of Indiana.

Drew was an officer in the United States Navy Judge Advocate General's Corps from 1992 to 1997 where he litigated cases, provided legal and ethics advice and training, and was certified in Total Quality Leadership process improvement. He served as a defense attorney, prosecutor, Staff Judge Advocate and was the Officer in Charge of a military police unit.

He has been a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation since 1997. As an FBI Special Agent in the Nashville, Tennessee from 1997-2004, he served as a legal and ethics advisor and investigated white collar, money laundering, cyber and transnational organized criminal enterprises, white collar crime and gangs. He is a former Sniper/Observer on the Memphis FBI SWAT team.

Drew has studied and worked internationally in training, crisis communications, and investigations of contract corruption, bribery, fraud, human trafficking, international kidnapping and cultural heritage theft. He has served as the Coordinator of the FBI Major Crimes Task Force in Baghdad, Iraq and on the International Contract Corruption Task Force in Kandahar, Afghanistan.

Since 2004, Drew has served as the FBI Chief Division Counsel leading a team responsible for ethics, compliance, legal guidance and government and community relations for the FBI throughout the state of Indiana. He is a Special Trial Attorney on the FBI Art Crime Team, served as the Division Compliance Officer, Training Coordinator, Media Coordinator and as the FBI Indianapolis Undercover Coordinator.

Drew has served on the Board of Directors at the Great Lakes Credit Union, the Indiana Bar Foundation, the Northwest Indiana Community Policing Initiative and as an advisor to the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy, the FBI Citizens Academy Alumni Board and the FBI Multicultural Advisory Committee.
