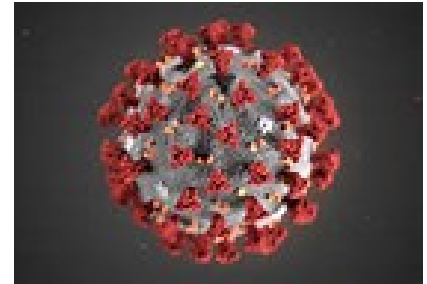
As a reminder, to avoid this illness, please follow the advice below;

Have you cut the weeds around your property to keep down fire danger? Please do your part to protect our community by keeping the weeds around your residence clear and away from your house.
