**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
INDIAN VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
UPDATING WATER POLICY 1.04.054**

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Indian Valley Community Services District (IVCSD) is a Special District within the County of Plumas, which exists and validly operates under the laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of IVCSD current water termination of service for non-payment states:

1.04.054 - The District will make an attempt to collect the amount due by a visit to the customer's premise 48 hours before service is to be shut off. A 48 hour notice ("FINAL ATTEMPT TO COLLECT BEFORE TERMINATION" notice) shall be given to the customer or a responsible adult. If neither is present, the notice will be left on the door of the premise. A duplicate copy of the 48 hour notice will be mailed on the same day to the address on the account. There will be a \$10.00 delinquent account processing fee charged for this procedure. And;

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors feels that a change from 48 to 72 hours in the above policy will best serve their water customers. An additional 24 hours is necessary due to the new payment policy of mailing payments to the processing center.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED The District Board of Directors of IVCSD changes the above policy from 48 to 72 hours.

The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Directors of the Indian Valley Community Services District, at a meeting of said Board held on the 13th day of February the year of 2008 by the following vote:
