Resolution of the Indian Valley Community Services District, Approving the Ordinance change to the Greenville and Taylorsville Sanitation Ordinances.

Whereas, the Indian Valley Community Services District (IVCSD) is a community services district, duly formed under, and operating pursuant to all of the laws, and provisions of the community services district Law, Government Code 61000 et. Seq., and

Whereas, the District operates a waste water/sewer system in Greenville, California, and Taylorsville, California, and

Whereas, on August 13, 2014, a second and final reading of changes to the Greenville and Taylorsville Sanitation/Waste water Ordinances was approved by the Board of Directors, at a regular, monthly board meeting, by a motion from Director Little, and Seconded by Director Shelters, and a roll call vote was held.

The policies of the IVCSD were followed in that these changes were initially reviewed in committee meetings, proposed as changes, and presented to the entire board, and multiple readings were completed in a timely manner, and roll call vote required as described in said policies.
