**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATE
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA) FOR A COMMUNITY FACILITIES GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Indian Valley Community Services District is located in a rural area of Northeastern California and serves a population of less than 5,000 residents; and

WHEREAS, The median household income of the proposed service area is below the higher of the poverty line or 60 percent of the State nonmetropolitan median household income; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Valley Community Service District has legal authority to borrow money, obtain security, repay loans, construct, operate, and maintain the proposed facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Valley Community Service District unable to finance the project from their own resources and/or through commercial credit at reasonable rates and terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Indian Valley Community Services District that:

The District is hereby authorized to apply for the Community Facilities Grant through the USDA that would provide 75% of the needed funds to purchase a Type I Fire Engine, and the District would be committed to funding the remaining 25% of the non-funded portion of the grant up to \$50,000 for the overall project.
