
WHEREAS, the hearing was advertized and noticed as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriations limitation to be established for **Beckwourth County Service Area**.



Receiving Sewage Disposal Services within
Taylorsville County Service Area
