RECITALS

WHEREAS, Indian Valley Community Services District (IVCSD) is a Special District within the County of Plumas, which exists and validly operates under the laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of IVCSD have met in a public meeting and discussed becoming a member of the Plumas County Special Districts Association (PCSDA). The purpose of PCSDA is to provide an opportunity for special districts to share their concerns, experiences and have a consolidated voice when the need arises. To inform the public of the role of special districts in Plumas County and to participate in statewide, regional and local organizations that affect the interests of special districts. To assist special districts in Plumas County and their boards in operating efficiently, equitably, and provide constructive means for improving functionality; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED The District Board of Directors of IVCSD intends to act in favor of becoming a member of PCSDA for a membership fee of \$20.00 annually with the understanding that at anytime IVCSD may withdraw membership and that no portion of the fees will be refunded back to IVCSD.
