A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
INDIAN VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT PROVIDING WORKERS'
COMPENSATION COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN DISTRICT VOLUNTEERS

Whereas, the District's Board of Directors desires to provide workers' compensation coverage for certain District volunteers pursuant to the provisions of Section 3363.5 of the Labor Code; and

Whereas, the District's Board of Directors finds its best interests will be served by utilizing volunteers in the provision of certain District services; and

Whereas, said volunteers should be eligible for workers' compensation coverage while on duty;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Indian Valley Community Services District that:

1. That the public interest is best served by providing workers' compensation coverage to fire department volunteers and Directors:
2. That the volunteers described above shall be deemed to be employees for the purposes of Division 4 of the California Labor Code while the person actually performs volunteer services, provided that the rights of volunteers shall be limited to those benefits set forth in the Labor Code.

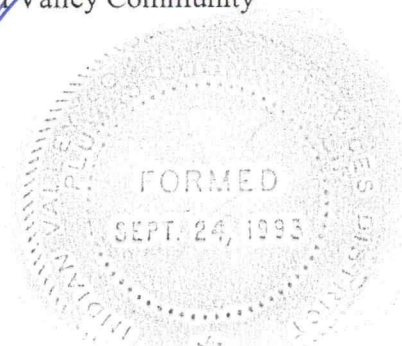

Topic: Approve Resolution 2017-011 Caltrans Property Easement
Date: November 8, 2017

Summary:

As the Board is aware, Caltrans completed extensive roadway work in the HWY 89 corridor this past summer. With that, there was extensive storm drain work done, especially near the fire department. A storm drain was placed next to the Fire Department and the Ferman's property.

Caltrans is willing to pay the District \$1,505.80 for the property rights conveyed in their agreement. \$1,000 of the \$1,505.80 is an incentive to have the paperwork completed by the District by 11/10/2017.

Attached are the required documents.

Recommendation:

Approve Resolution 2017-011 to provide Caltrans with a drainage easement on the Greenville Fire Department property and have the Board Chair sign the required documents.
